





# The Falcon

#### **Construction & Fabrication**

The Falcon was exclusively made in our Melbourne workshop. Its main components consist of a fibreglass and steel internal frame, a hand carved EPE foam body with stylised layered feathers, embellished with an in-house custom engineered gold vinyl wrap and a scenic paint finish. The features of the creature and the angular execution is a signature of other largescale works from our studio such as, The Guardian. The Falcon has been built using our signature boom-arm chassis for total mobility and range of motion. The chassis has five levers that operate the bird's body and head that allows it to tilt and rise. The levers also activate the tail feathers to fan in and out, as well as controlling the wings that are automated to flap and fold away using motors and electronic mechanisms. The puppet is completed with programmed light shows and soundscapes. Thousands of LED RGB pixels have been used throughout the puppet allowing multiple dazzling light sequences to form a key part of the performances. When the Falcon returned from its debut in Dubai, it was given a new painted finish to emphasise its unique and beautiful feathers.

### The Team

There are 12 members of The Falcon team, including:

- 8 professional puppeteers
- 2 technical specialists
- 1 puppetry director
- 1 production assistant

A minimum 30-minute break for our puppeteers is required after each performance, with a space where they can stretch and warm up. A Blanck Canvas has skilled educators who can equip and train local artists to perform The Falcon in your region.







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#### Performance

- Each performance of The Falcon runs for 35 minutes.
- Each leg and claw is puppeteered and can produce a range of realistic bird-like movements including walking and hopping. The enormous wings can fold as the Falcon explores and fully extend in a showstopping moment.
- The Falcons head is also puppeteered using a large rod with a trigger mechanism, this articulates the beak to open and shut when essential delivering the key defining head movements that are a signature of this beautiful creature in nature.
- The Falcons complex light sequences have been programmed to play in conjunction with unique soundscapes, including four short soundbursts that can be activated wirelessly. E.g. squawks, bird calls and other sounds. The longest unique light sequence is 35 minutes in duration allowing for a unique experience as the puppet performs.
- The Falcon is free-roaming and can traverse through large environments during a show.

## **\*\*** Technical Requirements

- The street gradient should be easy to moderate. Surface cannot be soft, e.g. sand, mud, thick grass; if path/road surfaces can't be used The Falcon will require tile such as a portable roadway or a temporary footpath to be laid on the intended performance path.
- Minimum 12-metre-wide path with a minimum 5-metre-high clearing.
- Surface must be able to support 800kg+ weight (Puppet, Puppeteers and Low-base Chassis).
- · Currently 2400 watt (Can be converted).
- Charging Station to power batteries in-between performances; Can perform for up to 2 hours on one charge. The Falcon can carry a spare set of batteries to increase performance to 4 hours before recharging.
- Length 5m, Width 10m, Height 4m.
- A storage area where the Falcon can be secured from the weather and be safely put to charge.
