Whether showcased as a vibrant static display or brought to life as roaming puppets, they captivate audiences with their bright colors by day and stunning illumination by night.



Construction & fabrication

The Fish are expertly crafted, rod-operated puppets designed to mesmerise audiences, whether as solo performers or in synchronised groups. Mounted on backpacks, they create lifelike, fluid movements that mimic the grace of swimming.

Constructed with a lightweight aluminum frame and hand-sculpted from durable EPE foam, each Fish is painted with high-quality Tautflex paints in a striking palette of yellows, greens, blues, and purples.

Operated by skilled puppeteers, the Fish can soar up to two meters above the crowd, with singular puppets maneuvered by hand-held rods. By day, they glide elegantly through the air, and by night, internal LEDs illuminate them, transforming them into glowing, ethereal creatures.

For static installations, the Fish can be mounted onto stationary frames, making them a dynamic addition to any space.

Additional Fish puppets can be custom-made upon request for an extra cost.

The Fish create a sense of fun. They convey realistic Fish-like movements that are unpredictable and playful which interest audiences young and old.

There are 6 members of The Fish team, including:

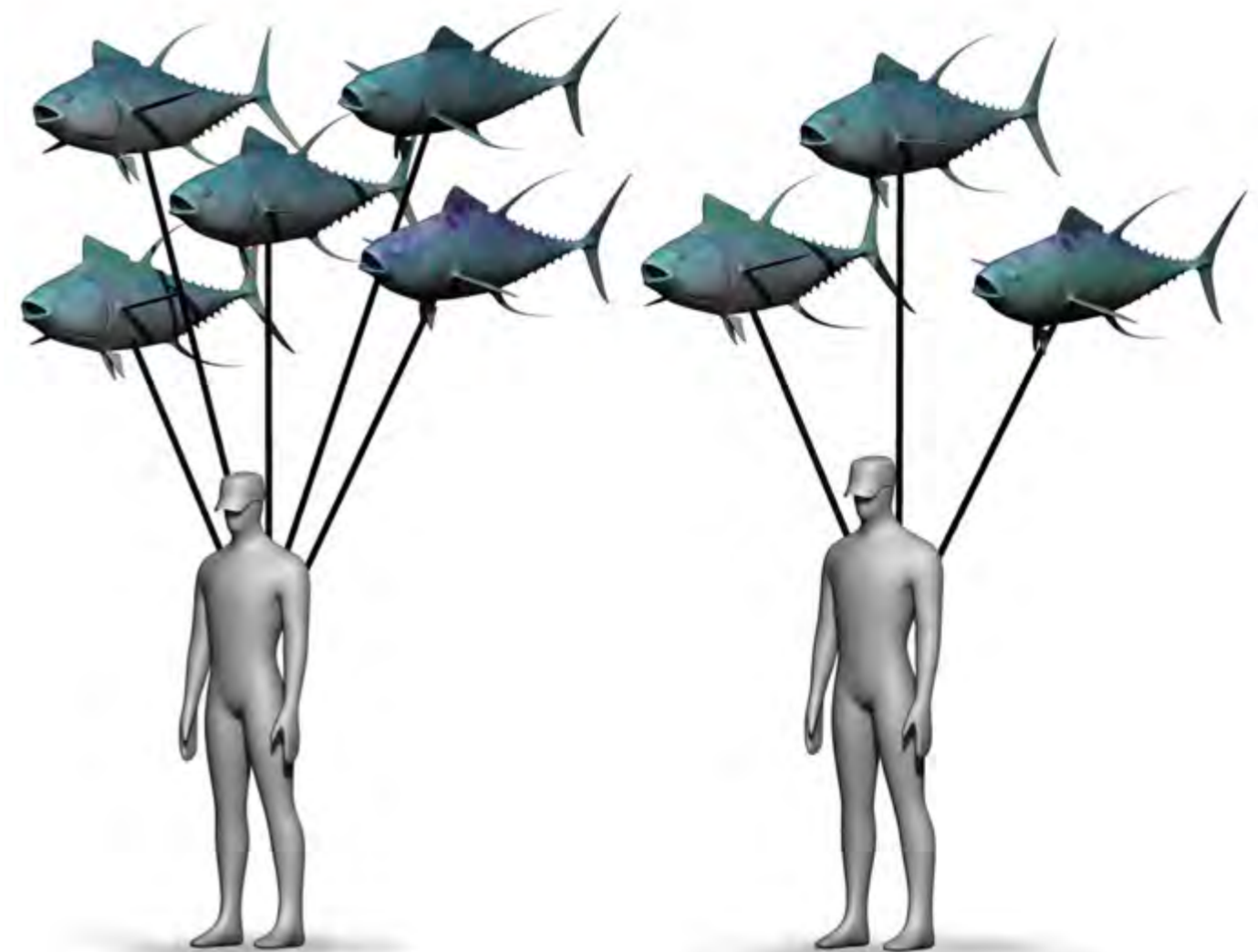
- 4 professional performers

Performance

The School of Tuna Fish features 10 lively puppets that engage and interact with audiences—split into two dynamic groups and two solo Fish on rods. With endless performance possibilities, they can playfully chase individuals, swim above the crowd, or be displayed as a stunning static installation.

Their vibrant bodies can illuminate and flash, creating a mesmerising spectacle as they “communicate” with their surroundings.

Each performance runs for 45 minutes, with a required 30-minute reset between shows.*
